

Man-Sask Church Capital Project Funding

Is your church in need of a new roof? New siding? Does your electrical need to be upgraded? Do you have water damage in your basement? Do you need a new kitchen for your fellowship hall? Does your sanctuary need to be updated? Does your parking lot need to be redone? Do you need a new church?

On November 26th, the offering will go to assist four churches with capital projects. Any offerings that are allocated to **Conf Advance – Church Development** on November 26th will be matched three to one for all donations up to a maximum of \$50,000. That means if the donations to **Conf Advance – Church Development** on November 26th total \$50,000 or more, then \$200,000 will be divided between the four approved church projects to a maximum of 80% of each project cost. Two thirds of these matching funds come from the Seventh-day Adventist Church in Canada (SDACC) with one third coming from the Man-Sask Conference.

How will the four church projects be chosen? Any church that is in need of funding for a capital project should complete and send the following information to the Man-Sask Conference Office c/o jtaer@mansaskadventist.ca

- 3 quotes on the cost of the project (if unavailable by Oct 10, please provide details of how the estimated cost of the project was calculated and send the three quotes if selected.);
- Narrative explaining the need for the project and the need for assistance (if more space is needed than provided above).

ADCOM will review the applications and selection one city church and one rural church from both Saskatchewan and Manitoba based on need as indicated in the narrative and pictures provided.

Timeline:

Oct 10: Deadline for church submissions

Oct 27: Decision on which four projects will be selected – based on greatest need

Nov 12: Material will be sent to all the churches for the **Conf Advance – Church Development**

Nov 26th: Offerings will be collected

Dec 10th: All remittance needs to be submitted by the churches to the Conference office

Dec 20th: Cheques will be sent to the four churches – based on their proportionate share of the donations up to a maximum of 80% of the project cost

2023: Before, during and after pictures will be published progressively in the Prairie Horizon

The four selected churches will be informed on Dec 20th as to the exact amount they will receive with no estimate available prior to that date. Any funds not needed for the project need to be returned.

Continuation of this program will depend on participation and availability of funds.
